Tastings ends at 5pm, after that it's time to socialize!

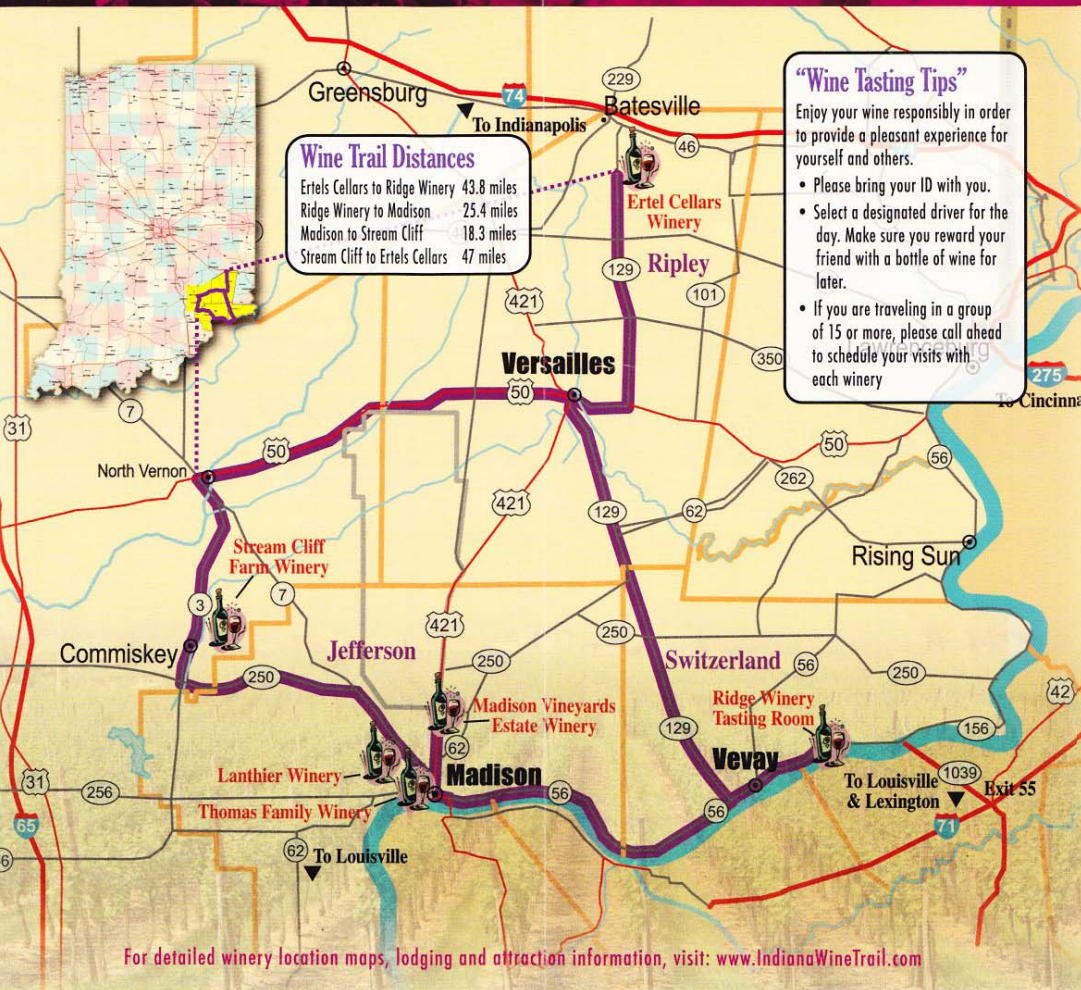

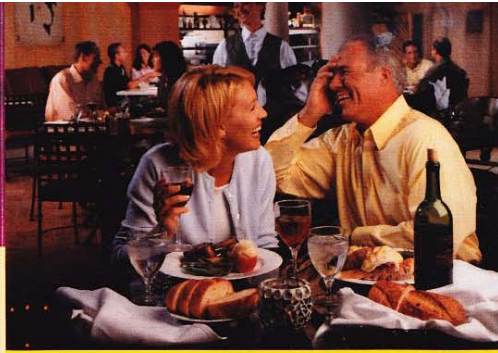


Wine Trail Distances

Enjoy your wine responsibly in order to provide a pleasant experience for yourself and others.

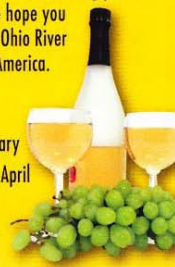
- Please bring your ID with you.
